A major feat of Gothic art, Notre-Dame Cathedral in Reims is considered something of a miraculous masterpiece given the heavy price the building paid during World War I.

Resurrected from the ruins, it embodies 800 years of remarkably unified architecture and a dizzying quest for light, not to mention a rich statuary that makes it the largest sculpted complex in Europe. Climbing the towers is an unusual way to discover this masterpiece as you get a close-up look at the chevet and the incredible reinforced

concrete framework designed by chief architect Henri Deneux.
